I heart you cushion by Le Monde de Sucrette



Helloooo! Thank you so much for purchasing this pattern! Hope you'll enjoy crocheting it! This little cute cushion was crocheted with a 100% acrylic chunky yarn and a 5mm crochet hook (a little smaller hook than the one suggested on the yarn which was 5.5mm

hook for a neater result and less holes)

<u>Type: Amigurumi</u> <u>Materials:</u> Yarn, hook, scissors, stuffing and a stitch marker.



I'll use the U.S terms for this pattern. Remember a dc in the U.K terms is a sc in U.S.and that will be the main used stitch for this pattern.



So? Are you ready??? I hope you'll enjoy making this sweet cushion to add a warm touch to your home or to give to your valentine ;)

Happy crocheting!

This pattern is made from up to down **PART A: The First bump: (the first side of the heart)**

Let's begin with the first bump.

Round1: In a circle of 4ch make 6sc

Use your stitch marker to mark the first stitch of each round you crochet so no need to close each rnd with a slip stitch.



Round2: Increase. Crochet 2sc on each sc of the previous round. T=12sc Round3: Increase. Crochet 1sc, 2sc, 1sc, 2sc, etc T=18sc Rnd4: Increase. Crochet 1sc, 2sc, 1sc, 2sc, etc T=27sc Rnd5: Increase. Crochet 1sc, 1sc, 2sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc, etc T=36sc Rnd6: Crochet one sc on each sc of the previous rnd. T=36sc Rnd7: Increase. Crochet 1sc, 1sc, 2sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc, etc T=48sc Rnd8: Crochet one sc on each sc of the previous rnd. T=48sc Rnd9: Increase. Crochet 1sc, 1sc, 2sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc, etc T=64sc Rnd10: Crochet one sc on each sc of the previous rnd. T=64 sc Now, you'll have a circle that lays flat but not completely. It curves a little bit.



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Rnd11, 12, 13 and 14: Crochet one sc on each sc of the previous rnd. T=64sc

Rnd15: Decrease: Crochet 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt (wt = worked together) etc T=56sc

Rnd16, 17, 18 and 19: Crochet one sc on each sc of the previous rnd. T=56sc

You finished the first bump of the heart that we are gonna call : PART A




Now you have to crochet another bump like you did for this first one and it will be PART B



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Now you have to join PART A and PART B with a line of 14sc like on these pics below. (Or you can sew them together on 14 stitches only)





So, let's continue crocheting around these two parts and make one round which will be rnd20. So,

rnd20 is (56-14) + (56-14)= 84sc (around PART A and B)



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Rnd21: Decrease: work 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, etc Rnd22, 23, 24 and 25: 1sc on each sc of the previous rnd. Rnd26: Decrease: work 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, etc



Rnd27: Decrease: work 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, etc Rnd28, 29, 30, 31 and 32: 1sc on each sc of the previous rnd. Rnd33: Decrease: work 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, etc Rnd34, 35 and 36: 1sc on each sc of the previous rnd.

Your heart is beginning to take shape.



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Rnd37: Decrease: work 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, etc Rnd 38 and 39: Work one sc on each sc of the previous round. Rnd40: Decrease: work 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, etc Rnd 41: Work one sc on each sc of the previous round. Rnd42: Decrease: work 1sc, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, 1sc, 1sc, 2sc wt, etc Rnd 43: Work one sc on each sc of the previous round.




STUFF HERE YOUR HEART. STUFF GOOD UNTIL YOU ARE PLEASED WITH THE SHAPE.

Continue now working 1sc, 2sc worked together, 1sc, 2sc worked together, etc etc until your heart is totally closed. Make one slip stitch.

Congratulations! Your heart is done! You can now embellish it with pompoms, flowers, buttons etc. Or you can leave it simple. I did a simple flower with a button in the middle with 3 leaves and sew them together on the heart. You can find their chart in the next page. Hope you'll enjoy making this heart :)
